


Summer Picnic/BBQ - August 25

Association Business Update

Year End Summary

As we get ready to close another year, here is a high level summary of the activities and the revenue and expenses.

Revenue

• Goal was to attain 110 members. Only reached 97. Actual revenue (less PayPal fees) was \$7708.

Expenses

- Our major expense continues to for landscaping services to regularly maintain the "common areas", with expenditures of \$2400.
- Social activity expenses included the Picnic (\$520) and the Progressive Dinner (\$521), for a total expense of \$1041.
- Printing the Directory totaled \$300.
- Administrative expenses included Website (\$180) and PO Box (\$46) and postage and printing (\$128), for a total expense of \$354.
- The Dumpster fee was \$600.
- Total expenses totaled \$3495. The remainder of revenue (approximately \$3500) has been allocated towards our next major improvement project. We are currently researching several options.
